RECRUITMENT OF ONE (01) INDIVIDUAL CONSULTANT TO REVIEW THE HARMONIZED BASIC TRAINING CURRICULA FOR NURSING AND MIDWIFERY IN ECOWAS FRENCH-SPEAKING COUNTRIES

Introduction

The West African Health Organisation (WAHO), a specialised institution of ECOWAS, has received grants from the World Bank for the implementation of several projects (**REDISSE, SWEDD, SM/NTD and WA-MRH**) and intends to use part of the SWEDD Project grant to make payments under the following contract: **“Recruitment of One (01) Individual Consultant to Review the Harmonised Training Curricula for Nursing and Midwifery in ECOWAS French-speaking Countries”**

Overarching Objective of the Mission

This review aims to improve the technical and pedagogical content of the Basic Training Curricula for Nursing and Midwifery in ECOWAS French-speaking countries.

Specific Objectives

More specifically, the consultant shall:

- Propose tools and guidelines to conduct the review of harmonised pre-service training curricula for nursing and midwifery,
- Guide countries in the performance of internal review of harmonised curricula,
- Collect, centralise and critically analyse the lapses and difficulties identified by countries in the implementation of harmonised Curricula,
- Make proposals for changes in the structure of the training programme, organisation, technical and pedagogical content (objective, content, etc.), teaching schedules and evaluation methods in the light of the deficiencies identified by the countries,
- Support WAHO in organising and facilitating the workshop to validate the revised Curricula.

Mission Commencement Date and Duration

Duration of Mission: 60 days. Commencement Date: November 2019.

Consultant's Profile

The Consultant shall:

- Have a higher degree in nursing/midwifery or other health related discipline;
- Have demonstrated expertise in teaching;
- Have at least 10 years' experience in instructional design and content development, including at least 5 years in a developing country, and at a strategic level related to the training of health workers (nurses and midwives) and particularly in the areas of training accreditation, evaluation and development of standards, regulations and practices in health training schools;

- Have a sound knowledge of the health system in ECOWAS countries;
- Have facilitation skills suited to a multidisciplinary team;
- Possess sound analytical abilities;
- Have a perfect command of the French language. Proficiency in the other official languages of ECOWAS (English, Portuguese) will be an asset;
- Knowledge of French-speaking countries and mastery of word processing and data analysis (Excel and Access databases) will be an asset.

The West African Health Organisation (WAHO) invites qualified individual consultants to express their interest in providing the aforementioned services.

Interested individual consultants must provide:

- A letter of expression of interest,
- A detailed, dated and signed Curriculum Vitae highlighting qualifications and experience in carrying out similar assignments, as well as references for possible checks,
- Signed financial proposal to carry out the mission.
