FINAL COMMUNIQUÉ

- The Nineteenth Ordinary Meeting of the Assembly of Health Ministers of the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS) took place at the KAIRABA BEACH HOTEL in Banjul, Republic of The Gambia, on 8 June, 2018.

- 8. ECOWAS Health Ministers reviewed in detail the items on the agenda of their meeting.

The Health Ministers followed the presentation of the 2017 Annual WAHO report with keen interest, the contents of which were centred on the 2017 regional health update, the programme and financial performance of the Organisation in connection with the implementation of its 2016-2020 Strategic Plan, and the new WAHO Director General's vision to address major health challenges in the region.
- 10. The Ministers underscored WAHO's commendable performance in the implementation of its 2017 Work Plan in line with its 2016-2020 Strategic Plan.
- 11. The Ministers thanked the Director General of WAHO and his team for all the work they had done and for the convincing results achieved in many areas.
- 12. The Assembly of Health Ministers unanimously adopted the 2017 WAHO Annual Report.
